It embodies the historic and architectural qualities of the Springfield neighborhood through its period of construction, its design, its historical associations and its integrity.

Constructed c. 1906, it was originally the residence of Ralph E. Miller, a printer with the Times-Union newspaper. In 1910, John J. McNamara, president of the Realty Company of Florida lived here.
