1551 Boulevard St. is a two story frame vernacular residential building. It is noteworthy for its unique details. It has been significantly altered by deterioration. It embodies the historic and architectural qualities of the Springfield neighborhood through its period of construction, its design, its historical associations and its integrity.

Constructed 1915, it was originally owned and built by L. Bucholtz, who lived here into the 1930's and who was a manager of a dry goods store.
