203-207 E. 3rd St. is a two-and-a-half-story frame vernacular multi-family residential building. It is noteworthy for its unusual placement of gable roofs and asymetrical massing. It has been significantly altered by the addition of a concrete block grocery on the corner of the house. It embodies the historic and architectural qualities of the Springfield neighborhood through its period of construction, its design, its historical associations and its integrity.

Constructed c. 1920, it was originally the residence of Eugene Kessler, inspector with the U. S. Immigration Service.
